“Red Colors, Ribbons, and Love ...

An Arizona Artists Exhibit

Exhibit Opening February 12, 2010

SunDust Gallery, a premier 4700 square foot artspace in downtown Mesa, Arizona...one block west of the internationally know Mesa Art Center, is pleased to offer a juried exhibition called ***“Red Colors, Ribbons, and Love”*** The exhibit is open to any original artwork by Arizona artists.

Submitted works of art can be represent photography, painting, sculpture, drawing, or any form of 3D and 2D work, including art forms like silversmith, blacksmith work, and jewelry.

Definition of **Red Colors, Ribbons, and Love** – Artwork that captures the feelings associated with the emotion of love through the use of colors, symbolism, form, or objects. Suggestions: clothing, adornments, romance, a sunset, wine and chocolate, the human figure, or the passion evoked from the use of colors, textures, touching, warmth, tingling, rough and smooth

The Red Colors, Ribbons, and Love Show is open to all amateur and professional artists living in Arizona. The exhibition will be a well rounded representation of every genre from realism, impressionism, abstract, etc. Works will be critiquing based on skill, technique, use of medium and other artistic based ideas.

Dates and Deadline: *Red Colors, Ribbons, and Love*

February 7, 2010 – Submission Closes

February 8, 2010 - Notification of Selection

February 8.9.10, 2010 – Artwork delivered to SunDust Gallery

February 12, 2010 – Exhibit Opening 6pm / 9pm

March 7, 2010 – Exhibit Closes

March 8,9,10, 2010 – Arrangements for art pick up at SunDust Gallery. Artist must pay shipping to and from SunDust Gallery. Artwork not picked up will be stored in Gallery basement for reasonable time.

Artwork Storage: Artwork left for over 30 days from close of show, will be subject to storage charges of \$5 per week, payable to gallery before artwork is released to owner.

Eligibility:

Show is open to all Arizona amateur / professional artists and is not limited to any styles or genres, in any medium. Submitted artwork must be original, must contain the theme as outlined in the opening section of this prospectus. Work must be ready to hang (no saw tooth hangers accepted), and clearly labeled with the artists name, artwork title, price, and contact information on back. No substitutions of accepted work. Sculpture, jewelry, and fine crafts must

have explanation of how they should be displayed. All work will remain on display during the duration of the exhibit. Art work must be for sale. SunDust gallery retains the right to selection, and placement of selected artwork.

Artwork Limitations: Generally there are no size limitations, but occasionally artists have extremely heavy, awkward, or large pieces that may not be appropriate for SunDust Gallery exhibit spaces. Wall art over 60" in length, requirements for special handling, or artwork that has electrical, moving, kinetic, or emit smells, heat, or sound must be approved prior to submittal. Artwork can be denied acceptance into exhibit based on unrealistic pricing, bad framing, potential gallery hazards, or offensive, or public nuisance issues. Gallery reserves right to make acceptance based on best interest of gallery and gallery clientele.

Application Fee:

Artist is asked to complete an online entry form and submit a non-refundable fee of \$25 for 1 to 3 images of artwork, and \$5.00 each for any additional image submittal. Payment must be made online at time of submission entry. Arrangements can be made for alternative submittals, including delivering artwork to gallery for review, or paper printed images, or photographs. Alternatives must be approved by gallery.

Calendar / Submission Notes:

All work must be shipped or delivered to SunDust Gallery, 48 West Main Street #100, Mesa, AZ 85201 during normal business hours of 10am and 4pm, Monday through Saturday. Chosen artwork will be featured at a special exhibition opening 2nd Friday of selected month. The reception will be publicized and open to the public. Exceptions to delivery hours can be arranged in advance when necessary.

Selection and Award

Final selections for the exhibition will be made by Professor of Art, a well know abstract artist and SunDust Gallery Owner Ronald T. Floyd, or another judge appointed before show submission closes.

Award: Three artists of distinction will be chosen who will be invited to exhibit their art as a Gallery Artist in a scheduled event in 2010.

Sales:

All works submitted must be for sale. By submitting the entry form, the artist grants the Gallery the right to sell the work (s) of art and agrees to terms of prospectus. The Gallery will devote its best efforts to the sale of all art. A sales commission of 30% will be retained by SunDust Gallery on all sales. Work will be sold for the price indicated on the entry form, if a pricing issue arises, the submitted electronic price will be selected. Work must remain available for sale in the Gallery for the duration of the exhibition. No early withdrawals will be permitted. Works that are sold by the Gallery will be marked as sold / and or removed from show.

Use Rights:

By submitting work to be considered for the exhibition, artists grant SunDust Gallery the right to use their image(s) for the purpose of marketing.

Online Submission Guidelines

1. You will be able to upload your image files on our web site during the registration process. We do accept CD, prints, and original art submittals by appointment with arrangements are made in advance.
2. The file name of each image should be clearly marked and identified with name of image and artist name.
3. Once the image deadline has passed, no image substitutions may be made nor changes in sale prices or titles as stated on entry form.
4. No restrictions are placed on image file upload size, but extremely large files that do not load properly will not be viewed.

Online Entry Application Guidelines:

The following information will be required to complete online entry form application for exhibit. It is best to compile this information ahead of starting to fill out the form.

Personal Data – Name, Email, Address, Home Phone, Cell Phone

Art Work Data – Title, Medium, Dimensions of work (framed size for 2-D, dimensions for 3-D), Weight – 3D work and 2D work with unusual hanging or display characteristics, Price of Work (including 30% sales commission). Unrealistic pricing of artwork can be grounds for refusal of submission.
